Expected Results

- Certification and accreditation of one CH-53E CFTD simulator
- Certification and accreditation of one (and as many as four) EAETs

Expected Benefits

- Reduced training costs via distributed network training
- Simultaneous training for assets located worldwide
- A stable and secure training network for the USMC

Problem

The Marine Corps needs to have their helicopter flight simulators certified and accredited so they can operate and train on a worldwide distributed USMC mission operations network. These trainers must have quarterly security updates implemented in order to be able to remain on the network.

Solution

- Phase I - Certify and accredit the CH-53E CFTD
- Phase II - Certify and accredit up to four Enhanced Aviation External Trainers (EAETs) which operate in conjunction with the CH-53E CFTD
