Expected Results

- Achieve an ATO for the LCS Trainer #1
- Develop and implement a centralized patch management system
- Develop and implement a centralized auditing system
- Develop and implement a centralized backup system

Expected Benefits

- Meet DoD and Navy requirement to operate securely
- Provide the ability to train with other LCS trainers
- Reduce maintenance costs by providing a centralized patch management, auditing and back up system

Problem

The Littoral Combat Ship trainers were designed, developed and delivered to the Shore Based Training Facility without being certified and accredited via the DIACAP process. These trainers must now go through the DIACAP process in order to remain in use.

Solution

- Ensure the LCS Trainer #1 can operate securely through the Navy and DoD certification and accreditation process
- Complete the DIACAP package and submit for an ATO
- Provide a centralized patch management, auditing and backup system to provide information assurance maintenance
