Expected Results

- Certification and accreditation of one simulator every five months
- Maintenance of quarterly security updates on all trainers with ATOs
- Achievement and maintenance of network security accreditation

Expected Benefits

- Reduced training costs via distributed network training
- Simultaneous training for assets located worldwide
- A stable and secure training network for the USMC

Problem

The Marine Corps needs to have their helicopter flight simulators certified and accredited so they can operate and train on a worldwide distributed USMC mission operations network. These trainers must have quarterly security updates implemented in order to be able to remain on the network.

Solution

- Phase I – Certify and accredit all 2nd MAW helicopter simulators and 2 new command centers
- Phase II – Certify and accredit all 3rd MAW helicopter simulators and 2 new command centers.
- Phase III – Certify and accredit 2 additional command centers
